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### Background:

At the September 24, 2018 Council Work Session staff presented a draft of the drainage study to the Council for discussion. The study has since been updated based on information provided by the residents on Grant Street and field work has been updated to verify the conditions. Last month staff met with the residents to go over the information and to discuss next steps in the process. At the Council Work Session staff will provide an overview and update to the information and options since originally presented in the study at the September work session.

The recommended alternative from an engineering standpoint is based on the technical merits, estimated cost, and ability to maintain private ownership of the properties on Grant Street. The recommended alternative would require a cooperative effort with the City of Excelsior in conjunction with their 2019 Street Improvement Project. Based on a conversation with Excelsior staff about the proposed alternative, staff offers the following comments should this option be pursued:

- The proposal and supporting data would need to be presented to the Excelsior City Council for their consideration.
- Runoff from this area of Shorewood currently drains overland to College Lake via the ditch along Highway 7. There are Excelsior resident concerns that have been communicated about the water level on College Lake, which lies within the city limits of Excelsior. The recommended alternative would maintain existing drainage patterns; however, directing runoff from Shorewood into Excelsior's storm sewer system may not be well-received by Excelsior residents.
- The Excelsior project is currently in detail design phase and is tentatively scheduled to be bid in March and awarded in April.
- The condition of Excelsior's existing culverts to College Lake would need to be inspected to determine if maintenance, repair or replacement is necessary.

- Long-term ownership and maintenance of the storm sewer would need to be addressed.

Staff requests direction on council's preferred alternative.
