ZONING PERMITS: A zoning permit shall be required for activities that do not require building permits but for which it is necessary to determine compliance with zoning requirements such as setbacks, impervious surface coverage, structure height, etc. The following items require a zoning permit:

- Accessory buildings less than 120 square feet in area and eight feet in height.
- Fences.
- Driveways.
- Temporary signs.
- Sport and tennis courts.
- Patios and sidewalks.
- Retaining walls higher than three feet (no separate permit required when a building permit is required for grading).
- Above-ground fireplaces and cooking facilities, but not including portable appliances.
- Irrigation systems.
- Playground equipment or systems occupying more than 64 square feet of ground area or exceeding six feet in height.
- Underground animal control fences.
- Tents and canopies erected for more than two weeks in a 12-month period.
- Portable storage facilities not associated with a valid building permit and located on property for more than 30 days in a 12-month period.

INFORMATION REQUIRED:

ALL APPLICATIONS:

A completed application form, and a survey or verifiable site plan, drawn to scale, illustrating the location of the proposed structure or improvement is required for all applications.

ACCESSORY BUILDINGS:

Elevation of the structure showing dimensions including length, width, and height. Specify the construction materials proposed to be used (exterior finish). The manufacturer's brochure or a photo with dimensions may suffice.

DRIVEWAY:

Illustrate the driveway on the survey or site plan to demonstrate setback from lot lines and configuration. Provide dimensions including width at street opening. Indicate the surface material to be used (asphalt or concrete).

FENCES:

Indicate the height of the fence, and style (e.g. alternating board-on-board, chain link, picket, etc.). Provide information regarding the width of and spacing between boards, slats or pickets. (Note: boundary line fences and fences in required front yards must be constructed in a manner that at least 25% of the plane between the ground and the top of the fence constructed is open.)

SPORT/TENNIS COURT:

Illustrate the court structure on the survey or site plan, including dimensions of the surface.

TEMPORARY SIGNS:

Show proposed location on the survey or site plan. Provide a drawing of the sign including dimensions. Indicate the proposed dates of display.
